

The eligible recipient shall:

- Be a graduating senior from Tyler Consolidated High School;
- Be the student who has shown the most improvement scholastically during the period beginning the sophomore year through the senior year, achieving at least a 3.2 grade point average and qualifying for admittance to an accredited program of continuing education. In the event of a tie, community service, sports and leadership involvement and financial need to be taken into consideration;
- Be accepted by and plan to attend (within twelve months of graduation from high school) an accredited program (certificate, associate, or bachelor's) providing education or training to enable pursuit of a profession of her or his choice;
- Have not previously received a scholarship from the Fund; and
- Not be a current recipient of another scholarship with the exception of a State or Federal entitlement program for which the graduate qualifies.
